Dear Generous Donor!

Life in Haiti this past year has reached a level of desperation and despair that is almost incomprehensible to us here at home: no functional government, rampant violence, fuel shortages, starvation, and preventable diseases, like diphtheria and cholera, killing old and young alike. Yet there is hope...

Dr. Myrthil, the director of the State Clinic in Limonade, sends this message to you:

Hi everybody. Thank you for thinking of our people in Haiti particularly in Limonade. Konbit Lasante pou Limonade is not only our partner, but it is one of us. Konbit is with us and tries always to be present in our life. By having mobile clinics with the State Clinic, helping with our health workers, and sending funds for resources like soap, condoms, Clorox (to purify water), rehydration packets, medicines, and buckets. The health workers use these resources to assist families. In this moment we are very afraid for the worst because the Health Ministry asks everyone to keep their eyes open because there are several cases of cholera in Port au Prince. Please don't give up, let us try to keep our eyes open together. We send this short message just to let you know that your work is not in vain.

While the current situation makes travel to Haiti dangerous, rest assured that **every dollar** of your donation provides that hope to the men, women, and children our organization serves. Funding:

- Salaries for four ajan sante (community health workers) who provides basic health visits, supplies, and education to families (\$2,500 per year for tireless, year round work)
- Mobile clinics to rural areas where medication, vaccines, evaluation, and education are provided (\$500 per clinic)
- Resources for the ajan sante to give to families (\$25 per family)
- Ongoing partnership with Children's Place International to continue supporting 24 families affected by HIV
